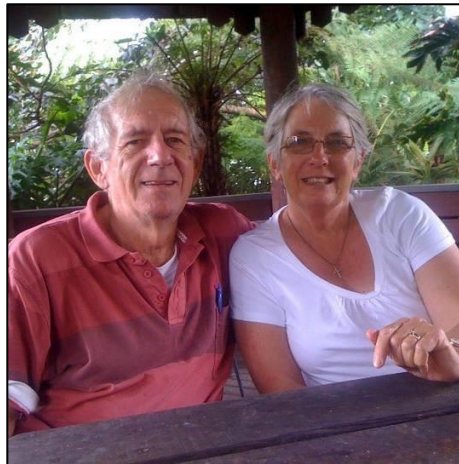

What is Messy Church?

Messy Church began in the UK in 2004, but has now spread across the world with many Messy Churches now operating in Australia and New Zealand.

Messy Church is for children and adults to enjoy together. It is an all age and fun environment to explore the Bible through messy (and not so messy) craft.

The celebration time also offers an opportunity to encounter God and grow closer to him. There is usually a story, prayer and songs for the whole family to enjoy.
